10 SME Data and Al Findings

Almost a quarter of SMEs think their data availability and accessibility are in good shape and have taken their first steps to deploy Al.	SMEs see humans deferring to Al without due checks as the most significant risk in implementing Al in their organisation—outranking exposure of sensitive data and creation of new attack vectors for cybercriminals.
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- Only one-third of SMEs think that AI will have a significant impact on helping their organisation make better data-based decisions.

 More than 20% of SMEs said that a lack of access to specialist third-party support is preventing them from implementing AI within their organisation.
- Around half of SMEs think it's necessary to review applications for Al compatibility to enable Al to help them make better data-based decisions.

 Introducing organisation-wide Al training is the top priority amongst SMEs to ensure they enable Al to help them make better data-based decisions.
- 26% of SMES are already implementing Al-driven analytics platforms. That's nearly twice as many as are implementing Al-powered chatbots.

 Just a quarter of SMEs say there is complete alignment between IT/technical teams and other business stakeholders on attitudes towards Al initiatives.
- SMEs think that cyber security threats and data security are two of the most significant barriers to implementing Al within their organisations.

 SMEs believe Al use cases for predictive maintenance are most likely to deliver tangible benefits—with 13% already seeing benefits and the majority (33%) expecting to do so in the next 7-12 months.
